Course Description and Training Objective

One day awareness & safety training course designed to provide foundational knowledge about improvised explosive devices (IEDs) and proper safety precautions and procedures for reacting and responding to unattended and suspicious items.

At the end of the course the attendees should gain a good awareness knowledge on the common precursors of explosives for making the IEDs, their explosive hazards and the indicators of suspicious items and appropriate responses to each and your role in preventing the threats.

Course outline

1. Basic theory of explosives, physical effects of chemical explosion, damage and injury Criteria.
2. Introduction to the 15 precursors of explosives their properties and characteristics regulated by the Singapore Arms and Explosives Acts and Regulations.
3. Awareness on the different types of IEDs; their method initiation and threats.
4. Case Review of some major historical IEDs attacks.
